Retinal evaluation is the most important part of a routine eye examination. Dilation drops are typically used to facilitate the examination of the retina. **In most cases, retinal imaging can replace the function of dilation drops**. The Optos Daytona provides an unequaled 200-degree view (82%) of your retina, while dilation only provides a 45-degree view (15%). This high-resolution, high-contrast digital image gives our doctor the opportunity to identify and follow peripheral retinal pathology much more easily.

To provide the highest level of care, retinal imaging is strongly recommended by the doctor for ALL patients annually.

It is ESPECIALLY important for people who have any of the following:

- 1. Floaters, spots or flashes of light in the vision
- 2. Family (or personal) history of macular degeneration or retinal disorders
- 3. Family (or personal) history of diabetes
- 4. Family (or personal) history of glaucoma
- 5. Family (or personal) history of hypertension or high cholesterol

The Optomap retinal Imaging is fast, easy, and comfortable. The results will be reviewed with you during your exam by the doctor.
