

EyeOptics Contact Lens Evaluation Information and Policy

A CONTACT LENS IS A MEDICAL DEVICE AND REQUIRES A PRESCRIPTION

➤ Patient Eligibility

- ❖ **Current/valid eye exam within a year**
- ❖ Additional **\$22** fee with **outside spectacle prescription** for contact evaluation
- ❖ Additional **\$20** fee for **second** contact prescription (clear or colored)
- ❖ Additional **\$30** fee for retraining/refresher training

➤ Evaluation Services Include:

- ❖ **More chair/doctor time**
- ❖ Evaluation of fit; **even if worn before**
- ❖ Evaluation of prescription; **even if no change**
- ❖ An evaluation of corneal health
- ❖ Discussion of comfort, solution & problems
- ❖ Possible change to a different type of contact lens
- ❖ Follow up appointments with Doctor, as needed
- ❖ A trial pair of contacts with updated prescription

- Every **NEW** contact lens wearer is **REQUIRED** to go through a **contact lens training course** which is 60 minutes.
 - If unsuccessful, we will schedule one additional training, and \$30 will be collected for time spent. For any additional trainings needed after 2 tries, we will collect \$30 per session. Once training is complete insurance will be applied.
 - All contact lens fees minus a \$30 service fee, will be refunded for new contact lens patients who decide to opt out of contacts either same day as training or within 2 weeks of training. If patient sees the doctor for a follow-up, the full training fee will be charged.
- **If a patient does not return within 30 days from the initial exam for their contact lens check to finalize their prescription, AN ADDITIONAL \$29 EVALUATION FEE WILL BE DUE.**
- **If a patient does not return within 6 months from the initial exam to finalize their contact lens prescription, another annual evaluation fee will be due.**
- **Cost of Lenses:** The cost of contact lenses is not included in the evaluation fee and is determined by the type of lens prescribed. Custom lenses such as hard contact lenses must be paid for at the time of dispense.
- **Returns:** **WE CANNOT ACCEPT RETURNS OR EXCHANGES ON MARKED, DAMAGED, OPENED, OR EXPIRED CONTACT BOXES.**
- **Refunds:**
 - ❖ There are no annual evaluation fee refunds **after follow-up with the doctor**
 - ❖ There are **no refunds** on contact lens purchases, as described above
- **Insurance:** Please contact your insurance provider to discuss your vision coverage.
- **Contact Lens Prescriptions:** **Contact lens prescriptions are valid for 1 year.**
- **Patient Responsibility:** Most people can wear contact lenses successfully without complication. However, those who abuse their contact lenses can develop serious, sight-threatening conditions. It is your responsibility to follow the wearing schedule, cleaning regimen, and follow-up care instructions. Contact lenses that feel fine can still be damaging to the eyes. This is why yearly eye appointments are necessary to ensure good eye health.

 - If unsuccessful, we will schedule one additional training, and \$30 will be collected for time spent. For any additional trainings needed after 2 tries, we will collect \$30 per session. Once training is complete insurance will be applied.
 - All contact lens fees minus a \$30 service fee, will be refunded for new contact lens patients who decide to opt out of contacts within 2 weeks of training. If patient sees the doctor for a follow-up, the full training fee will be charged.
- **If a patient is not being consistent and/or does not return within 30 days from the time of dispense for their contact lens check to finalize their prescription, AN ADDITIONAL \$29 EVALUATION FEE WILL BE DUE.**
- **If a patient does not return within 6 months from the initial exam to finalize their contact lens prescription, another annual evaluation fee will be due.**
- **Cost of Lenses:** The cost of contact lenses is not included in the evaluation fee and is determined by the type of lens prescribed. **Custom lenses must be paid for at the time of dispense.**
- **Exchanges/Returns:** Any contact lenses that are not finalized **MUST** be returned. All specialty lenses (excluding hybrid lenses) have up to 2 free exchanges within 90 days.
- **Refunds:**
